



## 2024 MEDIA ADMISSION POLICY

### CIRCUIT GILLES-VILLENEUVE

As of May 17th, 2024

Due to the preparations taking place prior to the FORMULA 1 AWS GRAND PRIX DU CANADA 2024 and in order to maintain a high level of security on the site, the following are the general policies for the media when accessing Circuit Gilles-Villeneuve as of Friday, May 17th.

- No relay trucks (microwave, satellite) are allowed on the site at all times.
- At all times for interview requests with a FORMULA 1 AWS GRAND PRIX DU CANADA spokesperson, please email your request to the Director General, Brand and strategy.

#### Non-accredited Media from June 5<sup>th</sup> to June 9<sup>th</sup> (inclusively)

- Non-accredited Medias who wish to cover live can do so on Ile Sainte-Hélène only. Please advise the press office before Tuesday, June 4<sup>th</sup> at 5 p.m.

#### Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> and Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>

- Circuit is closed.

#### Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>

- Only print media photographers and television cameramen are authorized to capture images and footage of the **Formula 1 team equipment** in the pits between **2 p.m. and 4 p.m.** You must notify the press office by email **no later than 10 a.m. on Monday.**
- Members of the media must remain in the pit lane. It is forbidden to walk into the garages. Please advise all photographers and cameramen.
- Photographers and cameramen must report to the entrance of the Cosmos Bridge, identify themselves, and proceed to the P17. The parking is [accessible](#) via the Seaway service road. Parking on the track is strictly prohibited at all times.



## Tuesday, June 4<sup>th</sup>

- Print, radio and television reporters are allowed in the pit lane between **2 p.m. and 4 p.m.**
- You must contact the Grand Prix du Canada press office by email the morning of your stopover to notify us of your visit, **even if you have already secured an appointment with a team at an earlier time.** It is pointless to make an appointment with a team before 2 p.m.
- Media must report to the entrance of the Cosmos Bridge, identify themselves, and proceed to the P17. The parking is [accessible](#) via the Seaway service road. Parking on the track is strictly prohibited at all times.
- Please note that the Media Centre is closed.

## Wednesday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup>

- **Coverage limited to accredited media ONLY.** Media Centre will open at 2:00 PM on Wednesday June 5<sup>th</sup>
- Please note that media credentials will be available for pick-up starting at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 5 at the Accreditation Centre located at the **Westin Montreal, at 270 Rue Saint-Antoine Ouest.**
- **Credential card holders** can access the site by using the Grand Prix shuttle service departing from the Westin Montréal, located on Saint-Antoine Ouest street. In order to use this service, passengers must display their official FIA/FOM credentials, previously acquired at the Accreditation Centre.
