### Circuit Gilles-Villeneuve

As of May 14, 2026

Due to preparations leading up to the FORMULA 1 LENOVO GRAND PRIX DU CANADA 2026 and in order to maintain optimal site security, the following general access rules to Circuit Gilles-Villeneuve will apply to all media representatives starting Friday, May 15, 2026.

#### Non-Accredited Media - May 20 to 24, 2026 (inclusive)

- Non-accredited media wishing to conduct live reports may do so on Île Sainte-Hélène only. Please notify the press office of your visit by email no later than Tuesday, May 19 at 5:00 p.m.

#### Saturday, May 16 and Sunday, May 17, 2026

- Site closed

#### Monday, May 18, 2026

- Only print media photographers and television camera crews are authorized between **2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.** to capture images of **team equipment in the pit lane**. You must confirm your intention to visit by email with the press office **no later than Monday at 10:00 a.m** and **arrive BEFORE 2:00 p.m.** at the checkpoint located at 2190 Pierre-Dupuy Avenue. After 2:00 p.m., access to the site will not be possible.
- Media representatives may circulate within the pit lane only. Access to team garages is strictly prohibited. Please inform your photographers and camera operators accordingly.
- You must report to the delivery checkpoint located at 2190 Pierre-Dupuy Avenue to receive a temporary pass before 2:00 p.m. You will then proceed to the Cosmos Bridge, check in with security, and head to Parking Lot P41, located along the Seaway. The parking lot is [accessible via the Seaway](#) service road. Parking on the circuit is strictly prohibited at all times.



## Tuesday, May 19, 2026

- Print media, radio, and television are authorized in the pit lane between **2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.**
- You must contact the press office by email the same morning **before 10:00 a.m.** to announce your visit, **even if you already have an appointment with a team before 2:00 p.m.** There is no possibility to schedule an appointment with a team before 2:00 p.m. You must arrive **BEFORE 2:00 p.m.** at the checkpoint located at 2190 Pierre-Dupuy Avenue. After 2:00 p.m., you will no longer be able to enter the site.
- You must report to the delivery checkpoint located at 2190 Pierre-Dupuy Avenue to receive a temporary pass before 2:00 p.m. You will then proceed to the Cosmos Bridge, check in with security, and head to Parking Lot P41, located along the Seaway. The parking lot is [accessible via the Seaway](#) service road. Parking on the circuit is strictly prohibited at all times.
- Please note that the Media Centre will be closed.

## Wednesday, May 20, Thursday, May 21, Friday, May 22, Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24, 2026

- **Coverage is reserved exclusively for accredited Formula 1 media representatives.** The Media Centre will open at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 20.
- Please note that Formula 1 media accreditations may be picked up starting at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 20 at the Accreditation Centre located at **Centre Sheraton Montreal : 1201 Boul. René-Lévesque O, Montréal, QC H3B 2L7.**
- **Accredited media representatives** may access the site using the Grand Prix shuttle service departing from the Sheraton Montreal Centre: 1201 Boul. René-Lévesque O, Montréal, QC H3B 2L7.

## NEW - CONCERT ACCREDITATIONS: Friday, May 22, Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24, 2026

- Concert coverage is **reserved for media representatives holding a Concert accreditation.**
- Concert accreditations provide **access to the site only from 6:00 p.m. on concert evenings.**
- For media accredited for concerts only, **site access will be exclusively through the Espace 67 entrance** starting at 6:00 p.m., where a dedicated access lane will allow entry to the concert area.
- **Please note that the Media Centre is reserved exclusively for Formula 1 accredited media.**
- Media passes for concerts only can be picked up on the evening of the concert. Details on how to pick them up will be provided once your accreditation has been confirmed.
- Formula 1 accredited media representatives wishing to also obtain concert accreditation may submit their request to Maxime Berthiaume at the Media Centre. An additional accreditation will be issued.
